The Jury became acquainted with the works submitted for the 5. International Salon *Still Nature in Photography* Częstochowa 2011.

The Jury performed a multi-stage assessment of 611 works submitted by 128 authors from Poland and abroad: Belarus, Russia, Lithuania, Ukraine, Israel, Germany, France, Slovenia, Austria, Denmark, the Netherlands, Australia, Serbia, Great Britain, Hungary, Italy, Bosnia and Herzegovina and Belgium. 186 works were accepted for the exhibition and the awards and medals were conferred.
